## Notice of streetscape improvement works and temporary changes to parking

Location of works: Literature Lane off Little Latrobe Street, Melbourne

Location of parking changes: Parking along north side of Little Latrobe Street between Swanston

and Elizabeth streets. Please check parking signs during the

construction period to avoid a fine.

Project: These works involve:

Installation of new drainage pipes

Install new kerb and channel and reconstruct asphalt footpath &

driveway

- Install electrical conduit and electrical pits

Reconstruct bluestone pitcher laneway

**Construction period:** Start date: Monday 20<sup>th</sup> April 2015 (weather permitting).

Times: 7:00am to 4:00pm

Duration: We anticipate that works will be completed in 8 weeks

(weather permitting).

To enable these construction works to proceed safely and efficiently there will be a need for temporary on-street parking changes. Please refer to parking signs during the construction period to avoid a parking fine.

These are substantial works which will involve disruption during the construction period. We will endeavour to reduce inconvenience wherever possible.

Staging of works: Works will be done in 2 stages to minimise disruption. Works will begin at the western end of the lane (Stage 1) followed by the eastern end of the lane (Stage 2).

**Local traffic management:** Local access for vehicles will be restricted due to the nature of the works. Please work with Citywide officers on site to organise deliveries.

**Noise:** The works will be noisy, including saw cutting or jackhammering. We will endeavour to keep this noise to a minimum.
